



The Coconino County Medical Reserve Corps. (MRC) was established by the Coconino County Public Health Services District to supplement existing resources and to help make our community more resilient in the event of a disaster. MRC volunteers participate in community preparedness activities, such as exercises for shelters, mass prophylaxis, vaccination clinics and other emergency scenarios and train with local response partners.

Being an MRC volunteer does not require specific time commitment beyond orientation and training- much of which can be obtained online at no charge. There are periodic meetings, trainings or drills for those who can attend.

MRC volunteers include medical and public health professionals such as physicians, nurses, medical assistants, pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, veterinarians, veterinarian technicians, and dentists. Local MRC members work with the Coconino County Public Health Services District and Emergency Services Office to support local public health initiatives.
